  - 8 – duotangs(Hilroy report covers) (Red, Green, Blue, Purple, Yellow)
  - 2 - **interlined** scribblers (no coils please)
  - 1 - interlined scribbler (**1/2 ruled, 1/2 plain**)
  - 1 - set of washable markers (8 pack)
  - 1 - pencil case or box
  - 1 - pencil sharpener w/container
  - 1 - box of Kleenex
  - 4 - Glad Large Zipper bags (10 ½ x 11)
